- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 276, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 276.0121 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 276.0121. LIABILITY FOR ENGAGING IN ORGANIZED ELECTION
- 8 FRAUD ACTIVITY. (a) In this section, "organized election fraud
- 9 activity" means an offense under Section 276.012(a).
- 10 (b) A person who engages in organized election fraud
- 11 activity in connection with an election in this state is liable to
- 12 the state for civil penalties in an action by the attorney general
- 13 <u>as provided by this section.</u>
- 14 (c) In an action under this section, the attorney general or
- 15 person bringing the action must establish each element of the
- 16 action by a preponderance of the evidence.
- 17 (d) It is not a defense under this section that:
- 18 <u>(1) a defendant is not criminally responsible for an</u>
- 19 offense committed in furtherance of the organized election fraud
- 20 <u>activity; or</u>
- 21 (2) another alleged participant in the organized
- 22 election fraud activity has been acquitted.
- (e) In all actions under this section, the state shall be
- 24 awarded a civil penalty of \$1,000 for each offense committed under

- 1 Titles 1 through 7 in the course of committing organized election
- 2 fraud activity.
- 3 (f) The cause of action created by this section is
- 4 cumulative of any other remedy provided by common law or statute.
- 5 (g) A person found liable under this section or other law
- 6 for any amount of damages arising from organized election fraud
- 7 activity is jointly liable with any other defendant for the entire
- 8 amount of damages arising from the activity.
- 9 (h) A civil action or proceeding under this section against
- 10 any person may be brought in the county where any part of the
- 11 organized election fraud activity occurred.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to an offense committed under Section 276.012(a), Election Code, on
- 14 or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed
- 15 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 16 effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is
- 17 continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section,
- 18 an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if
- 19 any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
