- 18 (b-1) Not later than the 14th day before the date of an

- 20 to the license holder who is the subject of the complaint a copy of
- 21 the record of any review conducted under Section 801.2055 of a
- 22 complaint requiring medical expertise. The board shall redact the
- 23 name of each veterinarian who conducted the review.
- (c) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), the [The] board

- 1 shall protect the identity of a complainant to the extent possible.
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 801.207, Occupations Code, as amended by
- 3 this Act, applies only to a complaint filed with the State Board of
- 4 Veterinary Medical Examiners on or after the effective date of this
- 5 Act. A complaint filed with the board before the effective date of
- 6 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the complaint
- 7 was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 8 purpose.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
