A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the requirement that the State Board of Veterinary 3 Medical Examiners provide a copy of a complaint to the subject of 4 the complaint.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 801.207, Occupations Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsection (b-1) and amending Subsection (c) to read as 8 follows:

9 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), the board shall 10 provide a copy of each complaint to the license holder who is the 11 subject of the complaint not later than the 14th day before the date 12 any response is due, unless providing a copy of the complaint would 13 jeopardize an investigation. The board may not require the license 14 holder to request a copy of the complaint.

Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), the [The] board 15 (c) 16 shall protect the identity of a complainant to the extent possible. SECTION 2. Section 801.207, Occupations Code, as amended by 17 this Act, applies only to a complaint filed with the State Board of 18 Veterinary Medical Examiners on or after the effective date of this 19 20 Act. A complaint filed with the board before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the complaint 21 was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that 22 23 purpose.
