- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 38.154, Education Code, is amended by 8 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 9 (a-1) A school district or open-enrollment charter school
  10 may include any medical professional who is licensed in this state
  11 as a member of the district or charter school concussion oversight
  12 team, provided that the professional meets the training requirement

- SECTION 2. Section 38.156, Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 38.156. REMOVAL FROM PLAY IN PRACTICE OR COMPETITION FOLLOWING CONCUSSION. A student shall be removed from an

- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
