- 6 (11) Special Agents of the Treasury Inspector General
- 7 for Tax Administration;
- 8 (12) Special Agents of the Office of Inspector General
- 9 of the United States Social Security Administration;

- 11 of the United States Department of Veterans Affairs;

- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
