A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 3 institutions or programs in foundation school program funds for
- 4 purposes of certain budget reductions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 19.007, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 8 (h) Notwithstanding any other law, for purposes of any
- 9 <u>budget reductions requested by the Legislative Budget Board or the</u>
- 10 governor, any money received by the district or appropriated to the
- 11 department for purposes of operating the district is considered to
- 12 be part of the foundation school program and is not subject to those
- 13 <u>budget reductions.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 29.259, Education Code, is amended by
- 15 adding Subsection (j-1) to read as follows:
- 16 <u>(j-1)</u> Notwithstanding any other law, for purposes of any
- 17 budget reductions requested by the Legislative Budget Board or the
- 18 governor, any money received by a nonprofit entity granted a
- 19 charter under this section or appropriated to the agency for
- 20 purposes of operating an adult education program under this section
- 21 is considered to be part of the foundation school program and is not
- 22 subject to those budget reductions.
- SECTION 3. Section 30.025, Education Code, is amended to
- 24 read as follows:

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- 1 Sec. 30.025. FUNDING OF TEXAS SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND AND
- 2 VISUALLY IMPAIRED. (a) The funding of the Texas School for the Blind
- 3 and Visually Impaired consists of:
- 4 (1) money the legislature specifically appropriates
- 5 to the school;
- 6 (2) money the agency allocates to the school under
- 7 this code;
- 8 (3) money paid under a contract or other agreement;
- 9 (4) money the school receives through a gift or
- 10 bequest;
- 11 (5) a payment the school receives from a school
- 12 district under Section 30.003; and
- 13 (6) the school's share of the available school fund and
- 14 payments to compensate for payments no longer made from the
- 15 available school fund as provided by Section 30.003(f).
- (b) Notwithstanding any other law, for purposes of any
- 17 budget reductions requested by the Legislative Budget Board or the
- 18 governor, any money received by the Texas School for the Blind and
- 19 Visually Impaired or appropriated to the agency for purposes of
- 20 operating the school is considered to be part of the foundation
- 21 school program and is not subject to those budget reductions.
- SECTION 4. Section 30.056, Education Code, is amended to
- 23 read as follows:
- Sec. 30.056. FUNDING OF THE TEXAS SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF. (a)
- 25 The funding of the Texas School for the Deaf consists of:
- 26 (1) money the legislature specifically appropriates
- 27 for the school;

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- 1 (2) money the agency allocates to the school under
- 2 this code;
- 3 (3) money paid under a contract or other agreement;
- 4 (4) money the school receives through a gift or
- 5 bequest;
- 6 (5) a payment the school receives from a school
- 7 district under Section 30.003; and
- 8 (6) the school's share of the available school fund and
- 9 payments to compensate for payments no longer made from the
- 10 available school fund as provided by Section 30.003(f).
- 11 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, for purposes of any
- 12 <u>budget reductions requested by the Legislative Budget Board or the</u>
- 13 governor, any money received by the Texas School for the Deaf or
- 14 appropriated to the agency for purposes of operating the school is
- 15 considered to be part of the foundation school program and is not
- 16 <u>subject to those budget reductions.</u>
- 17 SECTION 5. Section 37.012, Education Code, is amended by
- 18 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- (f) Notwithstanding any other law, for purposes of any
- 20 budget reductions requested by the Legislative Budget Board or the
- 21 governor, any money received by a local juvenile probation
- 22 <u>department or appropriated to the Texas Juvenile Justice Department</u>
- 23 for purposes of operating a juvenile justice alternative education
- 24 program is considered to be part of the foundation school program
- 25 and is not subject to those budget reductions.
- 26 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
