A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the composition of the governing body of the
- 3 independent organization certified to manage the ERCOT power
- 4 region.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 39.151(g), Utilities Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (g) To maintain certification as an independent
- 9 organization under this section, an organization's governing body
- 10 must be composed of persons specified by this section and selected
- 11 in accordance with formal bylaws or protocols of the organization.
- 12 The bylaws or protocols must be approved by the commission and must
- 13 reflect the input of the commission. The bylaws must specify the
- 14 process by which appropriate stakeholders elect members and, for
- 15 unaffiliated members, prescribe professional qualifications for
- 16 selection as a member. The bylaws must require the use of a
- 17 professional search firm to identify candidates for membership of
- 18 unaffiliated members. The process must allow for commission input
- 19 in identifying candidates. The governing body must be composed of:
- 20 (1) the chairman of the commission as an ex officio
- 21 nonvoting member;
- 22 (2) the counsellor as an ex officio voting member
- 23 representing residential and small commercial consumer interests;
- 24 (3) the chief executive officer of the independent

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1 organization as an ex officio voting member;
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- 2 (4) six market participants elected by their
- 3 respective market segments to serve one-year terms, with:
- 4 (A) one representing independent generators;
- 5 (B) one representing investor-owned utilities;
- 6 (C) one representing power marketers;
- 7 (D) one representing retail electric providers;
- 8 (E) one representing municipally owned
- 9 utilities; and
- 10 (F) one representing electric cooperatives;
- 11 (5) one member representing industrial consumer
- 12 interests and elected by the industrial consumer market segment to
- 13 serve a one-year term;
- 14 (6) one member representing large commercial consumer
- 15 interests selected in accordance with the bylaws to serve a
- 16 one-year term; [and]
- 17 (7) five members unaffiliated with any market segment
- 18 and selected by the other members of the governing body to serve
- 19 three-year terms; and
- 20 (8) one member unaffiliated with any market segment
- 21 who is a climate scientist selected by the other members of the
- 22 governing body to serve a three-year term.
- 23 SECTION 2. (a) An independent organization certified under
- 24 Section 39.151, Utilities Code, by the Public Utility Commission of
- 25 Texas before the effective date of this Act shall modify the
- 26 organization's governing body to comply with Section 39.151,
- 27 Utilities Code, as amended by this Act, as soon as practicable, but

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- 1 not later than September 1, 2021.
- 2 (b) After September 1, 2021, the Public Utility Commission
- 3 of Texas may decertify an independent organization whose governing
- 4 body does not comply with Section 39.151, Utilities Code, as
- 5 amended by this Act.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
