4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
6	modified by adding Section 38.0231 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 38.0231. GUIDELINES FOR USE OF DIGITAL DEVICES. (a)
8	The agency, in consultation with the Health and Human Services
9	Commission, shall develop and distribute for use by school
10	districts and open-enrollment charter schools health and safety
11	guidelines for best practices for the effective integration of
12	digital devices in public schools. The guidelines must:
13	(1) be based on evidence-based studies and practices;
14	(2) consider the potential costs of implementation of
15	the guidelines and affordable ways to reduce the hazards associated
16	with the extended use of digital devices; and
17	(3) address:
18	(A) digital device use for varying age ranges and
19	developmental levels;
20	(B) the amount of time a student spends using
21	digital devices in the classroom;
22	(C) appropriate frequency for breaks from the use
23	of digital devices;
24	(D) physical positioning of digital devices in

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1 the classroom; 2 (E) requiring the use of digital devices to 3 complete homework assignments; 4 (F) recommended total daily screen time usage for 5 students; and 6 (G) recommended teacher training regarding 7 digital device use in the classroom to ensure implementation of the 8 best practices. (b) The school board of each school district or the 9 governing body of each open-enrollment charter school may decide 10 whether to adopt the guidelines developed under Subsection (a) for 11 12 use in the district or school. (c) Each school district or open-enrollment charter school 13 14 that adopts the guidelines developed under Subsection (a) may 15 implement the guidelines in a manner that best meets the district's or charter school's individual needs. 16 17 (d) If a school district or open-enrollment charter school adopts the guidelines developed under Subsection (a), the district 18 19 or charter school shall: 20 (1) post the guidelines publicly on the district's or charter school's Internet website; and 21 (2) provide a copy of the guidelines with registration 22 materials and require the signature of the student's parent or 23 24 legal guardian acknowledging receipt of the guidelines. 25 SECTION 2. The Texas Education Agency shall develop and 26 distribute the guidelines for the use of digital devices required under Section 38.0231, Education Code, as added by this Act, for use 27

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1 beginning with the 2023-2024 school year.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
