7	USE. (a) The commission shall adopt rules to govern the treatment
8	and beneficial use of oil and gas waste.
9	(b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), rules adopted
10	under this section must not differ in treatment of commercial and
11	noncommercial recycling of fluid oil and gas waste.
12	(c) Rules adopted under this section must establish:
13	(1) minimum siting standards for commercial fluid
14	recycling pits;
15	(2) uniform technical and construction standards
16	consistent with noncommercial recycling standards for fluid oil and
17	gas waste;
18	(3) minimum and maximum bonding and financial security
19	amounts for commercial fluid recyclers; and
20	(4) standards for sampling and analysis of fluid oil
21	and gas waste.
22	(d) The commission shall approve or deny an application for
23	a permit issued under rules adopted under this section not later
24	than the 120th day after the date the complete application was

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1	received by the commission. If the commission does not approve or
2	deny the application before that date, the permit application is
3	considered approved and the applicant may operate under the terms
4	specified in the application for a period of one year.
5	(e) An application requesting a variance from the standards
