5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 418, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 418.059 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 418.059. REPORT ON BUILDING TRADE SERVICES FOLLOWING
8	DISASTERS. (a) Not later than November 1 of each year, the division
9	shall submit a report to members of the legislature on improving the
10	oversight, accountability, and availability of building trade
11	services following disasters. The report must include:
12	(1) the number and economic impact of tradespeople in
13	communities affected by a disaster;
14	(2) strategies for using a workforce that has been
15	trained in a United States Department of Labor Industry-Recognized
16	Apprenticeship Program or Registered Apprenticeship Program to
17	increase the availability of tradespeople, including plumbers and
18	electricians, following a disaster;
19	(3) approaches to increase prosecutions of alleged
20	fraud relating to building trade services offered following a
21	disaster, including wage theft and worker misclassification; and
22	(4) methods to encourage performance bond
23	requirements in contracts for building trade services to be
24	performed following a disaster.

(b) The division shall consult with appropriate state 1 entities, including the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service and 2 Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation, local governments, 3 4 trade associations, United States Department of Labor Registered Apprenticeship Programs, and law enforcement groups in preparing 5 6 the report described by Subsection (a). (c) The report described by Subsection (a) must include the 7 methodology of the contents of the report, including the type and 8 nature of information provided by the entities described by 9 Subsection (b). 10
