- (b) The program must: 13
- 14 (1) provide assistance only for unusually high bills

- (2) establish criteria for determining whether a bill 17

- (3) allow a customer to apply for assistance to the 19
- municipally owned utility, electric cooperative, or retail 20
- electric provider that served the customer during the time period 21
- in Subdivision (1); and 22
- 23 (4) require a municipally owned utility, electric
- cooperative, or retail electric provider that receives an 24

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- 1 application under Subdivision (3) to:
- 2 (A) submit the application to the comptroller;
- 3 <u>and</u>
- 4 (B) provide to the customer any assistance sent
- 5 by the comptroller to the utility, cooperative, or provider in
- 6 response to the application.
- 7 <u>(c) The comptroller shall consult with the commission when</u>
- 8 adopting any rules needed to implement this section.
- 9 (d) The commission may enforce a rule adopted by the
- 10 comptroller to implement this section.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
