## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to the authority of the Texas Department of Insurance to 3 rescind a certificate of compliance issued for an improvement for 4 purposes of coverage through the Texas Windstorm Insurance 5 Association.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Section 2210.2515(k), Insurance Code, is amended 8 to read as follows:

9 (k) The department may <u>not</u> rescind a certificate of 10 compliance <u>after issuing the certificate</u> [<del>issued</del>] under this 11 section [<del>if the department finds that the improvement does not</del> 12 <del>comply with the applicable building code under the plan of</del> 13 <del>operation</del>]. [<del>The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary to</del> 14 <del>implement this subsection.</del>]

15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a 16 certificate of compliance that is in effect or issued on or after 17 the effective date of this Act.

18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
