- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 2210.2515(k), Insurance Code, is amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (k) The department may not rescind a certificate of
- 10 compliance <u>after issuing the certificate</u> [issued] under this
- 11 section [if the department finds that the improvement does not
- 12 comply with the applicable building code under the plan of
- 13 operation]. [The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary to
- 14 implement this subsection.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 16 certificate of compliance that is in effect or issued on or after
- 17 the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
