11	(1) is 18 years of age or older;									
12	(2) has a high school diploma or the equivalent of a									
13	high school diploma;									
14	(3) completes a training course on rental locating									
15	approved by the commission;									
16	(4) has not, in the two years preceding the date of the									
17	application, held a rental locator permit issued under this									
18	section;									
19	(5) is sponsored by a licensed broker;									
20	(6) is currently enrolled in qualifying real estate									
21	courses required for a sales agent or broker license; and									
22	(7) pays an application fee in an amount set by the									
23	commission.									
24	(b) A rental locator permit expires on the 120th day after

1	the	date	of	issuance	and	may	not	be	renewed.	

- 2 (c) Notwithstanding Section 1101.351(a), a person who holds
- 3 <u>a permit issued under this section may act as a residential rental</u>
- 4 locator. The permit holder must be supervised by the sponsoring
- 5 <u>broker</u>.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
