3	intentional shutoff of electric and water service.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 91, Property Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 91.007 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 91.007. NOTICE REQUIRED FOR EMERGENCY UTILITY SHUTOFF.
8	Not later than four hours after a landlord receives a notice under
9	Section 17.011, Utilities Code, or Section 13.1397, Water Code, for
10	the emergency shutoff of electric power or water for a dwelling or
11	commercial building leased to a tenant, the landlord shall notify
12	the tenant of the shutoff by e-mail or text message. The notice must
13	include:
14	(1) the estimated time and date that the electric
15	power or water will be restored to the dwelling or building; and
16	(2) whether the shutoff is part of a rolling outage if
17	the shutoff is for electric power.
18	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 17, Utilities Code, is
19	amended by adding Section 17.011 to read as follows:
20	Sec. 17.011. NOTICE REQUIRED FOR INTENTIONAL OUTAGES. Not
21	later than three hours after an electric utility, municipally owned
22	utility, or electric cooperative intentionally shuts off electric
23	power to a customer in response to an emergency event, the utility
24	or cooperative shall notify the customer of the shutoff by e-mail or

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1	text message. The notice must include the following information:
2	(1) the estimated time and date that the utility or
3	cooperative will restore electric power to the customer; and
4	(2) whether the shutoff is part of a rolling outage.
5	SECTION 3. Subchapter E, Chapter 13, Water Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 13.1397 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 13.1397. NOTICE REQUIRED FOR INTENTIONAL SHUTOFF OF
8	SERVICE. Not later than three hours after a retail public utility
9	intentionally shuts off water service to a customer in response to
10	an emergency event, the utility shall notify the customer of the
11	shutoff by e-mail or text message. The notice must include the
12	estimated time and date that the utility will restore water service
13	to the customer.
14	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
