1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the establishment of a memorial monument dedicated to
 1-18 emergency medical services personnel on the Capitol grounds.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Chapter 443, Government Code, is amended by
 1-21 adding Section 443.01527 to read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 443.01527. MEMORIAL MONUMENT FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL
 1-23 SERVICES PERSONNEL. The State Preservation Board may approve and
 1-24 establish an appropriate memorial monument on the State Capitol
 1-25 grounds dedicated to emergency medical services personnel, as
 1-26 defined by Section 773.003, Health and Safety Code, in this state.
 1-27 The State Preservation Board may only use private contributions
 1-28 made for a purpose related to the memorial monument to create,
 1-29 establish, and perpetually maintain the monument.

1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
