- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 64.012(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person commits an offense if the person:
- 8 (1) votes or attempts to vote in an election in which
- 9 the person knows the person is not eligible to vote;
- 10 (2) knowingly votes or attempts to vote more than once
- 11 in an election;
- 12 (3) knowingly votes or attempts to vote in an election
- 13 <u>in this state after voting in another state in an election in which</u>
- 14 a federal office appears on the ballot and the election day for both
- 15 states is the same day;
- 16 (4) knowingly votes or attempts to vote a ballot
- 17 belonging to another person, or by impersonating another person; or
- 18 (5) (4) knowingly marks or attempts to mark any
- 19 portion of another person's ballot without the consent of that
- 20 person, or without specific direction from that person how to mark
- 21 the ballot.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
