- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 241, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 241.012 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 241.012. TRAINING FOR GOVERNING BODY OF RURAL
- 8 HOSPITAL. (a) In this section, "rural hospital" means a hospital
- 9 licensed under this chapter that is:
- 10 (1) located in a county with a population of less than
- 11 60,000; or

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- 12 (2) designated by the Centers for Medicare and
- 13 Medicaid Services as a critical access hospital, rural referral
- 14 center, or sole community hospital and is not located in an area
- 15 defined by the United States Office of Management and Budget as a
- 16 metropolitan statistical area.
- 17 (b) A rural hospital shall provide to a member of the
- 18 <u>hospital's governing body</u>, on the member's request, an education
- 19 and training course on the governing body's powers and duties and
- 20 <u>other appropriate topics.</u>
- 21 (c) The course provided under Subsection (b) must be:
- (1) developed using requirements and standards
- 23 determined by the Center for Optimizing Rural Health of the Texas
- 24 A&M Rural and Community Health Institute or a successor

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- 1 organization;
- 2 (2) provided at no cost to the requesting member; and
- 3 (3) available in an electronic format.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
