BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 7B, Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended by adding Article 7B.0085 to read as follows: 8 9 Art. 7B.0085. REPORTING. For an original or modified protective order issued under this subchapter, on receipt of the 10 order from the clerk of the court, a law enforcement agency shall 11 12 immediately, but not later than the third business day after the date the order is received, enter the information required by 13 14 Section 411.042(b)(6), Government Code, into the statewide law enforcement information system maintained by the Department of 15 16 Public Safety. 3 SECTION 3. Article 66.252, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 4 amended by amending Subsections (b) and (d) and adding Subsections 5 (d-1) and (h) to read as follows:

6 (b) The arresting law enforcement agency shall prepare a 7 uniform incident fingerprint card described by Article 66.251 and 8 initiate the reporting process for each offender charged with:

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(1) a felony;

10 (2) a misdemeanor for which a term of confinement may 11 be imposed; or

12 (3) a misdemeanor punishable by fine only that 13 involves family violence[, as defined by Section 71.004, Family 14 Code].

(d) Except as provided by Subsection <u>(d-1) or</u> (e) or as otherwise required by applicable state law or rule, information or data required by this chapter to be reported to the Department of Public Safety or the Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall be reported promptly but not later than the 30th day after the date on which the information or data is received by the agency responsible for reporting it.

22 (d-1) A conviction for an offense involving family violence
23 that would prohibit a person from possessing a firearm under state
24 or federal law shall be reported to the Department of Public Safety

Subchapter D, Chapter 411, Government Code, is 3 amended by adding Section 411.0525 to read as follows: 4 Sec. 411.0525. REPORTING OF CERTAIN PROTECTIVE ORDERS AND FAMILY VIOLENCE MISDEMEANOR CONVICTIONS. (a) In this section: 5 6 (1) "Family violence misdemeanor" means a misdemeanor 7 crime of domestic violence as defined by 18 U.S.C. Section 921. 8 (2) "Protective order" means a court order described by 18 U.S.C. Section 922(g)(8). 9 10 (b) The department shall report to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for use with the National Instant Criminal Background 11 12 Check System each protective order and each conviction for a family violence misdemeanor not later than the fifth calendar day after 13 the date the department receives information that the protective 14 15 order or judgment of conviction was entered. SECTION 5. Articles 7B.0085, 7B.054, and 66.252(d-1), Code 16 17 of Criminal Procedure, as added by this Act, apply only to a protective order or judgment of conviction entered on or after the 18

19 effective date of this Act.

20 SECTION 6. Section 411.0525, Government Code, as added by 21 this Act, applies only to information received by the Department of 22 Public Safety of the State of Texas on or after the effective date 23 of this Act.

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SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
