4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 32.02474 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 32.02474. ELIGIBILITY OF PERSONS DIAGNOSED WITH SICKLE
8	CELL DISEASE FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE. (a) Notwithstanding any
9	other law, the commission shall provide medical assistance to all
10	persons:
11	(1) who are diagnosed with sickle cell disease;
12	(2) who apply for the assistance; and
13	(3) for whom federal matching money is available.
14	(b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary
15	to implement this section.
16	SECTION 2. Section 32.02474, Human Resources Code, as added
17	by this Act, applies only to an initial determination or
18	recertification of eligibility of a person for medical assistance
19	under Chapter 32, Human Resources Code, made on or after the date
20	the section is implemented, regardless of the date the person
21	applied for that assistance.

22 SECTION 3. As soon as possible after the effective date of 23 this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human 24 Services Commission shall take all necessary actions to expand

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eligibility for medical assistance under Chapter 32, Human
Resources Code, in accordance with Section 32.02474, Human
Resources Code, as added by this Act, including notifying
appropriate federal agencies of that expanded eligibility.

5 SECTION 4. If before implementing any provision of this Act 6 a state agency determines that any other waiver or authorization 7 from a federal agency is necessary for implementation of that 8 provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the 9 waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that provision 10 until the waiver or authorization is granted.

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
