8	Sec. 2252.251. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
9	(1) "Governmental entity" means the Health and Humar
10	Services Commission, the Department of State Health Services, or a
11	political subdivision as defined by Section 2252.201.
12	(2) "Manufacturing process" means the application of a
13	process to alter the form or function of materials or elements of a
14	product in a manner that adds value and transforms the materials or
15	elements into a new finished product.

- 16 (3) "Personal protective equipment" means specialized
- 17 clothing or equipment worn for protection against communicable and
- 18 other infectious diseases.
- 19 (4) "Produced in the United States" means a product
- 20 for which all manufacturing processes occur in the United States.
- Sec. 2252.252. PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT PURCHASING
- 22 REQUIREMENTS. (a) Except as provided by Section 2252.253, a
- 23 governmental entity purchasing personal protective equipment shall
- 24 ensure the bid documents provided to all bidders and the contract

- 1 include a requirement that the personal protective equipment be
- 2 produced in the United States.
- 3 (b) A governmental entity subject to the purchasing
- 4 requirements described by Subsection (a) shall adopt rules to
- 5 promote compliance with this section.
- 6 Sec. 2252.253. EXEMPTIONS. Section 2252.252 does not apply
- 7 to the purchase of personal protective equipment for which the
- 8 governing body of the governmental entity responsible for the
- 9 purchase determines that:
- 10 (1) personal protective equipment produced in the
- 11 United States is not:
- 12 (A) produced in sufficient quantities;
- 13 <u>(B) reasonably available; or</u>
- 14 (C) of a satisfactory quality;
- 15 (2) use of personal protective equipment produced in
- 16 the United States will increase the total cost of the purchase by
- 17 more than 20 percent; or
- 18 (3) complying with that section is inconsistent with
- 19 the public interest.
- Sec. 2252.254. CONFLICT OF LAW. To the extent of any
- 21 conflict or inconsistency, this subchapter prevails over any other
- 22 state law relating to the purchase of personal protective equipment
- 23 that is directly funded by a governmental entity or financed by
- 24 funds administered by a governmental entity.
- 25 SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 2252, Government Code, as
- 26 added by this Act, applies only to bid documents submitted or
- 27 contracts entered into on or after the effective date of this Act.
