1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the staggering of terms of aldermen on the governing
 1-20 body of a Type A general-law municipality.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 22.034, Local Government Code, is
 1-23 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-24 (d) If the aldermen of the governing body of a municipality
 1-25 are not serving staggered terms of office as provided by Subsection
 1-26 (b), the governing body by majority vote may provide for the
 1-27 staggering of terms by requiring the drawing of lots by the
 1-28 aldermen.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
