H.B. No. 3705

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a child's eligibility for the Medicaid buy-in program 3 for children. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 531.02444, Government Code, is amended 5 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as 6 7 follows: The executive commissioner shall develop and implement: 8 (a) 9 (1) a Medicaid buy-in program for persons with disabilities as authorized by the Ticket to Work and Work 10 11 Incentives Improvement Act of 1999 (Pub. L. No. 106-170) or the 12 Balanced Budget Act of 1997 (Pub. L. No. 105-33); and 13 (2) subject to Subsection (a-1) as authorized by the 14 Deficit Reduction Act of 2005 (Pub. L. No. 109-171), a Medicaid buy-in program for children with disabilities [that is] described 15 by 42 U.S.C. Section 1396a(cc)(1) whose family incomes do not 16 exceed 300 percent of the applicable federal poverty level. 17 18 (a-1) The executive commissioner by rule shall increase the maximum family income prescribed by Subsection (a)(2) for 19 determining eligibility for the buy-in program under that 20 21 subdivision of a child who is eligible for the medically dependent children (MDCP) waiver program and is on the interest list for that 22 23 program to the maximum family income amount allowable, considering available appropriations for that purpose. 24

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SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
amended by adding Section 531.024441 to read as follows:

Sec. 531.024441. MEDICAID BUY-IN PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN: DISABILITY DETERMINATION ASSESSMENT. (a) The commission shall, at the request of a child's legally authorized representative, conduct a disability determination assessment of the child to determine the child's eligibility for the Medicaid buy-in program for children implemented under Section 531.02444.

9 <u>(b) The commission shall directly conduct a disability</u> 10 <u>determination assessment of a child under this section and may not</u> 11 <u>contract with a managed care organization or other entity to</u> 12 <u>conduct the assessment.</u>

13 SECTION 3. Section 531.024441, Government Code, as added by 14 this Act, applies to a request for a disability determination 15 assessment to determine eligibility for the Medicaid buy-in program 16 for children made on or after the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 4. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the waiver or authorization is granted.

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
