3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 493, Government Code, is amended by
5	adding Section 493.034 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 493.034. POLICY AND TRAINING RELATED TO INMATES WHO
7	IDENTIFY AS TRANSGENDER. (a) The department shall adopt a policy
8	regarding the confinement of inmates who identify as transgender.
9	The policy must:
10	(1) ensure that a transgender inmate's privacy is
11	respected while confined, including with respect to:
12	(A) the inmate's use of bathroom and shower
13	<pre>facilities;</pre>
14	(B) conducting invasive searches of the inmate;
15	and
16	(C) the inmate's clothing and personal items; and
17	(2) provide a process for transgender inmates to
18	report harassment.
19	(b) The department shall provide training to each
20	correctional officer employed by the department regarding
21	transgender inmates and gender identity and the policy adopted
22	under Subsection (a).
23	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 501, Government Code, is

amended by adding Section 501.028 to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 501.028. INFORMATION CONCERNING INMATES WHO IDENTIFY
- 2 AS TRANSGENDER. (a) The department, during the diagnostic
- 3 process, shall record information relating to whether an inmate
- 4 <u>identifies as transgender.</u>
- 5 (b) The department shall maintain information obtained
- 6 under this section separate from the inmate's file and the
- 7 information may only be accessed by department employees when
- 8 necessary.
- 9 SECTION 3. Subchapter D, Chapter 501, Government Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Section 501.115 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 501.115. HOUSING OF INMATES WHO IDENTIFY AS
- 12 TRANSGENDER. The department shall house an inmate who identifies
- 13 <u>as transgender in a facility, dormitory, or cellblock that houses</u>
- 14 inmates of the gender with which the inmate identifies.
- 15 SECTION 4. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 16 of this Act, the Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall adopt
- 17 the policy and training required by Section 493.034, Government
- 18 Code, as added by this Act.
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
