A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

<u>L</u>	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the release and inclusion of extraterritorial
- 3 jurisdiction by a municipality involving certain areas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 42, Local Government Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 42.0253 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 42.0253. RELEASE AND INCLUSION OF EXTRATERRITORIAL
- 8 JURISDICTION: CERTAIN AREAS. (a) This section applies only to an
- 9 area that is located in:
- 10 <u>(1) the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a</u>
- 11 municipality; and
- 12 (2) a county with a population of less than 75,000 that
- 13 is adjacent to three counties with populations of more than
- 14 450,000.
- 15 (b) A majority of the registered voters in an area subject
- 16 to this section may petition the municipality to release the area
- 17 from the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction. The
- 18 petition must be filed with the secretary or clerk of the
- 19 municipality.
- 20 (c) Not later than the 10th day after the date the secretary
- 21 or clerk receives a petition under Subsection (b), the secretary or
- 22 <u>clerk shall determine whether the petition is valid. If the</u>
- 23 petition is determined valid, the governing body of the
- 24 municipality shall immediately enter in the minutes or records of

- 1 the municipality an order releasing the area from the
- 2 municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction.
- 3 (d) An area released under Subsection (c) becomes an
- 4 unincorporated area of the county. A municipality may include the
- 5 area in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction if:
- 6 (1) the municipality is otherwise eligible to include
- 7 the area in its extraterritorial jurisdiction under this chapter;
- 8 and
- 9 (2) the municipality receives a petition signed by a
- 10 majority of the registered voters of the area requesting inclusion.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
