18	identification of gift card information, including gift card

20	(5) circumvents a security measure, access control

23	Sec. 328.002. ENFORCEMENT BY ATTORNEY GENERAL; INJUNCTION.
24	(a) The attorney general may investigate a claim that a person

2	(b) If the attorney general believes that a person is
3	violating this chapter, the attorney general may bring an action in
4	the name of the state to restrain or enjoin the person from
5	violating this chapter.
6	(c) The attorney general is entitled to recover all
7	reasonable costs of bringing an action under this section,
8	including court costs, reasonable attorney's fees, and
9	investigation costs.
