2	relating to the exemption of certain vehicles from vehicle towing
3	regulations.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2308.002(11), Occupations Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(11) "Tow truck" means a motor vehicle, including a
8	wrecker, equipped with a mechanical device used to tow, winch, or
9	otherwise move another motor vehicle. The term does not include:
10	(A) a motor vehicle owned and operated by a
11	governmental entity, including a public school district;
12	(B) a motor vehicle towing:
13	(i) a race car;
14	(ii) a motor vehicle for exhibition; or
15	(iii) an antique motor vehicle;
16	(C) a recreational vehicle towing another
17	vehicle;
18	(D) a motor vehicle used in combination with a
19	tow bar, tow dolly, or other mechanical device if the vehicle is not
20	operated in the furtherance of a commercial enterprise;
21	(E) a motor vehicle that is controlled or
22	operated by a farmer or rancher and used for towing a farm vehicle;
23	(F) a motor vehicle that:
24	(i) is owned or operated by an entity the

- 1 primary business of which is the rental of motor vehicles; and
- 2 (ii) only tows vehicles rented by the
- 3 entity;
- 4 (G) a truck-trailer combination that is owned or
- 5 operated by a dealer licensed under Chapter 2301 and used to
- 6 transport new vehicles during the normal course of a documented
- 7 transaction in which the dealer is a party and ownership or the
- 8 right of possession of the transported vehicle is conveyed or
- 9 transferred; or
- 10 (H) a car hauler that is used solely to
- 11 transport, other than in a consent or nonconsent tow, motor
- 12 vehicles as cargo:
- (i) in the course of a prearranged shipping
- 14 transaction;
- 15 (ii) in the course of a commercial
- 16 transaction for transport arranged or authorized by one business
- 17 for the shipping or delivery of a damaged vehicle to another
- 18 business; or
- 19 (iii) for use in mining, drilling, or
- 20 construction operations.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
