8	INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS. (a) A political subdivision may not, as
9	part of a severance package or as part of any other agreement or
10	settlement made in relation to the termination of a person's
11	employment or contract as an independent contractor, make a payment
12	to an employee or independent contractor if:
13	(1) the payment would:
14	(A) be paid from tax revenue; and
15	(B) exceed the amount of compensation, at the
16	rate at the termination of employment or the contract, the employee
17	or independent contractor would have been paid for 20 weeks; or
18	(2) the employee or independent contractor was
19	terminated for misconduct.
20	(b) A political subdivision shall post each severance
21	agreement in a prominent place on the political subdivision's
22	Internet website.
23	SECTION 2. Section 180.008, Local Government Code, as added
24	by this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or after the

1 effective date of this Act.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
