## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the penalty for violating certain executive orders,
- 3 proclamations, or regulations issued by the governor.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 418, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 418.027 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 418.027. PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF ORDER, PROCLAMATION,
- 8 OR REGULATION. Notwithstanding any other law, including Section
- 9 418.173(b), the punishment prescribed for violating an executive
- 10 order, proclamation, or regulation issued by the governor under
- 11 this chapter may not include a term of confinement.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 14 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 15 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 16 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 17 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 18 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 19 before that date.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
