- 2 relating to the use of lifeguards and informational signs to
- 3 improve safety on public beaches.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 61.065, Natural Resources Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) As part of the duty under this section to clean and
- 8 maintain the condition of public beaches, a municipality shall:
- 9 <u>(1) during reasonable daylight hours for the months of</u>
- 10 March through November, provide occupied lifeguard towers on each
- 11 side of each pier, jetty, or other structure that protrudes into the
- 12 Gulf of Mexico that is located within the corporate boundaries; and
- 13 (2) post within 100 yards of each side of each
- 14 structure described by Subdivision (1) signs clearly describing the
- 15 dangerous water conditions that may occur near the structure.
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 61.066, Natural Resources Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 61.066. DUTY OF COUNTY. (a) It is the duty and
- 19 responsibility of the commissioners court of any county located or
- 20 bordering on the Gulf of Mexico to clean and maintain the condition
- 21 of all public beaches located inside the county but outside the
- 22 boundaries of any incorporated city located or bordering on the
- 23 Gulf of Mexico and all public beaches owned by the county and
- 24 located inside the boundaries of an incorporated city, town, or

- 1 village.
- 2 (b) As part of the duty under this section to clean and
- 3 maintain the condition of public beaches, a county shall:
- 4 (1) during reasonable daylight hours for the months of
- 5 March through November, provide occupied lifeguard towers on each
- 6 side of each pier, jetty, or other structure that protrudes into the
- 7 Gulf of Mexico that is located on a public beach described by
- 8 Subsection (a); and
- 9 (2) post within 100 yards of each side of each
- 10 structure described by Subdivision (1) signs clearly describing the
- 11 dangerous water conditions that may occur near the structure.
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 61.067, Natural Resources Code, is
- 13 amended by adding Subsection (a-2) to read as follows:
- 14 (a-2) As part of the duty under this section to clean and
- 15 maintain the condition of public beaches located within state
- 16 parks, the department shall:
- 17 (1) during reasonable daylight hours for the months of
- 18 March through November, provide occupied lifeguard towers on each
- 19 side of each pier, jetty, or other structure that protrudes into the
- 20 Gulf of Mexico that is located within a state park; and
- 21 (2) post within 100 yards of each side of each
- 22 <u>structure described by Subdivision (1) signs clearly describing the</u>
- 23 dangerous water conditions that may occur near the structure.
- SECTION 4. Subchapter A, Chapter 13, Parks and Wildlife
- 25 Code, is amended by adding Section 13.023 to read as follows:
- Sec. 13.023. LIFEGUARDS AND SIGNAGE IN CERTAIN AREAS. The
- 27 department shall:

- 1 (1) during reasonable daylight hours for the months of
- 2 March through November, provide occupied lifeguard towers on each
- 3 side of each pier, jetty, or other structure that protrudes into the
- 4 Gulf of Mexico that is located within a state park; and
- 5 (2) post within 100 yards of each side of each
- 6 structure described by Subdivision (1) signs clearly describing the
- 7 dangerous water conditions that may occur near the structure.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
