- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 51.9716 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.9716. CONFIDENTIALITY OF STUDENT DIRECTORY
- 8 INFORMATION. (a) In this section, "institution of higher
- 9 <u>education" has the meaning assigned by Section 61.003.</u>
- 10 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c) and to provide
- 11 privacy protections in addition to those provided under the Family
- 12 Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (20 U.S.C. Section
- 13 1232g), an institution of higher education may not sell or release
- 14 information the institution designates as directory information
- 15 about a student under that federal law, including the student's
- 16 name, e-mail address, physical address, and telephone number,
- 17 unless the student or the student's parent, if applicable, provides
- 18 the institution written consent.
- 19 (c) An institution of higher education is not prohibited
- 20 <u>from releasing designated directory information if the institution</u>
- 21 releases the information under an exception provided under the
- 22 Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (20 U.S.C.
- 23 Section 1232g(b)) for the release of education records without the
- 24 written consent of a student or a student's parent, if applicable.
