(a) Not later than January 31 of each 24

No. 3818 even-numbered year, the commissioner shall adjust for inflation in 1 accordance with Subsection (b) the amounts required to be paid by an 2 3 insurance carrier: 4 (1) for a medical examination under Section 5 408.0041(a), (f), or (f-2); and 6 (2) as a fee under Section 408.0041(h)(2) for the 7 failure or refusal of an employee to appear at the time scheduled 8 for a medical examination to which that subdivision applies. (b) The commissioner shall compute the amount of 9 an adjustment under Subsection (a) based on the percentage increase, 10 if any, in the consumer price index for this state published by the 11 12 Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor for the preceding 24-month period ending January 1. 13 14 (c) An adjustment under this section takes effect beginning 15 March 1 of the year of the adjustment. Not later January 16 than 31, 2022, the 17 commissioner of workers' compensation shall: set the initial amount of the fee under Section 18 (1) 408.0041(h)(2), Labor Code, as added by this Act; and 19 (2) make the initial adjustment to the 20 amounts required to be paid for a medical examination under Section 21 408.0041(a), (f), or (f-2), Labor Code, in accordance with Section 22 408.00411, Labor Code, as added by this Act. 23 SECTION 4. Not 24 later than January 31, 2024, the 25 commissioner of workers' compensation shall make the initial adjustment to the fee under Section 408.0041(h)(2), Labor Code, as 26 added by this Act, in accordance with Section 408.00411, Labor 27

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1 Code, as added by this Act.

SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act to Section 408.0041, Labor Code, apply only to a medical examination that occurs or is scheduled to occur, as applicable, on or after March 1, 2022. A medical examination that occurs or is scheduled to occur, as applicable, before that date is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
