- 9 Sec. 574.038. ESTABLISHMENT OF REGIONAL ASSISTED
- 10 OUTPATIENT TREATMENT PROGRAMS. The commissioners courts of two or
- 11 more counties may establish a regional assisted outpatient
- 12 treatment program to provide court-ordered outpatient mental
- 13 <u>health services under this chapter in the participating counties.</u>
- 14 Sec. 574.039. PROGRAM IN CERTAIN COUNTIES MANDATORY. (a)
- 15 The commissioners court of a county with a population of more than
- 16 200,000 shall undertake to establish a program under this chapter
- 17 and apply for federal and state funding to cover program costs. The
- 18 criminal justice division of the governor's office may assist a
- 19 county in applying for federal funding.
- (b) A county is required to establish a program under this
- 21 section only if the county receives federal or state funding
- 22 specifically for that purpose in an amount sufficient to pay the
- 23 program costs.
- (c) A county that is required to establish a program under

- 1 this section and fails to establish or to maintain that program is
- 2 ineligible to receive grant funding from this state or any state
- 3 agency.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
