A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT 2 relating to the display of emergency and other notices by a 3 governmental entity on the entity's Internet website. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. (a) This section takes effect only if the Act of 6 the 87th Legislature, Regular Session, 2021, relating to 7 nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted codes 8 becomes law.

9 (b) Subchapter E, Chapter 2051, Government Code, as added by 10 Chapter 1029 (H.B. 305), Acts of the 86th Legislature, Regular 11 Session, 2019, is redesignated as Subchapter F, Chapter 2051, 12 Government Code, and amended by adding Section 2051.203 to read as 13 follows:

14 <u>Sec. 2051.203. REQUIRED POSTING OF NOTICE. (a) In this</u> 15 <u>section "governmental entity" has the meaning assigned by Section</u> 16 2051.041.

17 (b) A governmental entity shall post in a prominent location
 18 on the home page of the entity's Internet website:

19 (1) each emergency notification issued by the entity;
20 and
21 (2) any other official notice issued by the entity,
22 including notices regarding the entity's ability or inability to
23 provide services the entity normally provides to the public.

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1 2051.152(b)], this subchapter applies only to a political 2 subdivision with the authority to impose a tax that at any time on 3 or after January 1, 2019, maintained a publicly accessible Internet 4 website.

5 SECTION 4. (a) This section takes effect only if the Act of 6 the 87th Legislature, Regular Session, 2021, relating to 7 nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted codes does 8 not become law.

9 (b) Section 2051.151, Government Code, as added by Chapter 10 1029 (H.B. 305), Acts of the 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 11 2019, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2051.151. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. Except as provided by <u>Sections</u> [Section] 2051.152(b) and 2051.153, this subchapter applies only to a political subdivision with the authority to impose a tax that at any time on or after January 1, 2019, maintained a publicly accessible Internet website.

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

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
