5	SECTION 1. Section 251.012, Health and Safety Code, is

7	Sec. 251.012. EXEMPTIONS FROM LICENSING REQUIREMENT. The
8	following facilities are not required to be licensed under this
9	chapter:
10	(1) a home and community support services agency that
11	is licensed under Chapter 142 with a home dialysis designation and
12	that:
13	(A) has not more than five patients at any time as
14	a total number of patients to whom the agency provides dialysis
15	services; or
16	(B) is certified by the Centers for Medicare and
17	Medicaid Services as an end stage renal disease facility under
18	<pre>Medicare;</pre>
19	(2) a hospital licensed under Chapter 241 that
20	provides dialysis only to individuals receiving:
21	(A) inpatient services from the hospital; or

- 2 (3) a hospital operated by or on behalf of the state as

- 8 confinement in a facility operated by or under contract with the

- 12 network established under Chapter 501, Government Code, that

- 15 under contract with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice; or
- 16 (5) the office of a physician, other than an [unless
- 17 the] office [is] used primarily as an end stage renal disease

- 19 (A) has not more than five patients at any time as
- 20 <u>a total number of patients to whom the office provides dialysis</u>
- 21 services; or
- 22 (B) is certified by the Centers for Medicare and
- 23 Medicaid Services as an end stage renal disease facility under
- 24 Medicare.
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
