- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 43.05(a), Penal Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 43.05. COMPELLING PROSTITUTION.
- 8 (a) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly:
- 9 (1) causes another by force, threat, coercion, or fraud to
- 10 commit prostitution. +
- 11 (2) causes by any means a child younger than 18 years to
- 12 commit prostitution, regardless of whether the actor knows the age
- 13 of the child at the time of the offense.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to conduct
- 15 that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act, except that
- 16 a final conviction for an offense that exists on the effective date
- 17 of this Act is unaffected by this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
