- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 92, Property Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 92.0521 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 92.0521. LANDLORD'S DUTY TO INSPECT FOR AND TREAT
- 8 BEDBUGS; DISCLOSURE. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b),
- 9 during a tenant's lease term or during a renewal or extension, the
- 10 landlord has a duty to inspect and treat, at the landlord's expense,
- 11 the leased premises for bedbugs.
- 12 (b) A tenant may decline in writing the landlord's
- 13 <u>inspection for and treatment of bedbugs under Subsection (a).</u>
- 14 (c) A provision stating the landlord's duty under this
- 15 section must be included in a lease agreement signed by the tenant.
- SECTION 2. Section 92.0521, Property Code, as added by this
- 17 Act, applies only to a lease entered into or renewed on or after the
- 18 effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
