A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the resumption of employment by certain retirees within

- 3 the Texas Municipal Retirement System.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 852.108, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a), (c), (e), (f), (h), (i), and (j) and
- 7 adding Subsections (b-1), (k), (1), (m), and (n) to read as follows:
- 8 (a) In this section and Sections 852.1085 and 852.109, a
- 9 person's reemploying municipality is the municipality for which the
- 10 person most recently performed [was performing] creditable service
- 11 <u>before</u> [at the time of] the person's retirement with respect to the
- 12 person's particular individual account under this subtitle.
- 13 (b-1) Unless subject to Subsection (c), the retirement
- 14 annuity of a person subject to this section is not suspended.
- 15 (c) If a person becomes an employee of the person's
- 16 <u>reemploying municipality at any time during the 12 con</u>secutive
- 17 months after the effective date of the person's last retirement
- 18 from the reemploying municipality, the [The] retirement system
- 19 shall discontinue and suspend the full amount of the monthly
- 20 payments of the [each] service retirement annuity that is allowed
- 21 because of the person's previous <u>retirement from</u> [service with] the
- 22 reemploying municipality beginning with the month the retirement
- 23 system determines that the person has again become an employee of
- 24 the reemploying municipality. After the suspension and except as

- 1 provided by Subsection (j), the retirement system may not make
- 2 payments of the annuity for any month during which the person
- 3 remains an employee of the reemploying municipality. The
- 4 suspension of a benefit under this section does not suspend payment
- 5 of a benefit to an alternate payee under a qualified domestic
- 6 relations order.
- 7 (e) After termination of employment with the reemploying
- 8 municipality and after filing of an application for resumption of
- 9 retirement with the board of trustees, a person described by
- 10 Subsection $\underline{\text{(c)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(b)}}{\text{)}}$] is entitled to receive future payments of the
- 11 suspended annuity, as provided by Subsection (f), and to the
- 12 additional benefits as provided by Subsections (g), (h), (i), and
- 13 (j).
- 14 (f) Monthly payments of an [a suspended] annuity suspended
- 15 <u>under Subsection (c)</u> shall <u>resume beginning with</u> [be resumed in]
- 16 the month following the month in which employment is terminated
- 17 with the reemploying municipality, without change in the amount
- 18 except for any increase allowed under Section 854.203 or the
- 19 duration of or another condition pertaining to the suspended
- 20 benefit. Except as provided by Subsection (j), payment of the
- 21 resumed benefit may not be made for any month during which the
- 22 payment was suspended under this section.
- 23 (h) The additional service retirement benefit allowable to
- 24 a person to whom this section applies is, at the option of that
- 25 person, either:
- 26 (1) a refund of accumulated contributions made since
- 27 reemployment plus any accrued interest on the accumulated

- 1 contributions allowed by the retirement system; or
- 2 (2) a benefit consisting of:
- 3 (A) a basic annuity actuarially determined from
- 4 the sum of the member's contributions [deposits] made and
- 5 accumulated since the date the person last became a member,
- 6 together with interest accumulated on that amount since the person
- 7 last became a member and an amount from the benefit accumulation
- 8 fund equal to the amount of the member's contributions credited to
- 9 the member's individual account since the person last became a
- 10 member together with interest accrued on that amount since the
- 11 person last became a member; or
- 12 (B) a greater amount authorized by the
- 13 municipality under Section 855.501.
- (i) The additional benefit described by Subsection (h)(2)
- 15 $\left[\frac{h}{h}\right]$ is payable as a standard service retirement benefit or, at the
- 16 election of the member, any optional benefit authorized under this
- 17 subtitle that is the actuarial equivalent of the standard
- 18 retirement benefit. The first benefit payment date under this
- 19 subsection is the later of the end of the month following the last
- 20 month of employment or the end of the month following the month in
- 21 which the person files an application for payment. The first
- 22 payment may not be made if the person has resumed employment with
- 23 the reemploying municipality in a position that would make the
- 24 person an employee at any time during the 12 consecutive months
- 25 after the effective date of the person's last retirement from the
- 26 reemploying municipality.
- (j) Subject to Subsection (m), a [A] person who resumed

- 1 employment with the person's reemploying municipality before
- 2 September 1, 2021, [to whom this section applies] shall receive a
- 3 lump-sum payment in an amount equal to the sum of the service
- 4 retirement annuity payments the person would have received had the
- 5 person's annuity payments not been discontinued and suspended under
- 6 this section as it existed on the date the person resumed employment
- 7 with the reemploying municipality, if the person:
- 8 (1) initially retired based on a bona fide termination
- 9 of employment; and
- 10 (2) resumed employment with the person's reemploying
- 11 municipality at least eight years after the effective date of the
- 12 person's retirement.
- 13 (k) If the annuity payments of a person who resumed
- 14 employment with the person's reemploying municipality before
- 15 <u>September 1, 2021, were discontinued and suspended under this</u>
- 16 <u>section as it existed on the date the person resumed employment with</u>
- 17 the reemploying municipality, on filing of a written application
- 18 with the retirement system, the retirement system shall, subject to
- 19 Subsection (1), resume making the annuity payments to the person,
- 20 provided:
- 21 (1) the person's retirement that preceded the
- 22 resumption of employment was based on a bona fide termination of
- 23 employment;
- 24 (2) the person did not become an employee of the
- 25 person's reemploying municipality at any time during the 12
- 26 consecutive months after the effective date of the person's
- 27 retirement described by Subdivision (1); and

- 1 (3) the person has not terminated employment with the
- 2 reemploying municipality.
- 3 (1) Monthly payments of an annuity suspended under
- 4 Subsection (k) shall resume beginning with the month following the
- 5 month in which the written application is approved by the
- 6 retirement system without change in the amount except for any
- 7 <u>increase allowed under Section 854.203 or the duration of or</u>
- 8 another condition pertaining to the suspended benefit. Except as
- 9 provided by Subsection (j), payment of the resumed benefit may not
- 10 be made for any month during which the payment was suspended under
- 11 this section as it existed on the date the person resumed employment
- 12 with the reemploying municipality.
- 13 <u>(m) At the time a person files a written application to</u>
- 14 resume benefits under Subsection (k), the retirement system shall
- 15 pay the person any lump-sum payment owed to the person under
- 16 Subsection (j).
- 17 <u>(n) The board of trustees may adopt rules to implement this</u>
- 18 section.
- 19 SECTION 2. Sections 852.109(a), (e), and (f), Government
- 20 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 21 (a) If a person becomes an employee of a municipality after
- 22 the effective date of the person's [beginning to receive a]
- 23 retirement <u>from a participating municipality</u> [benefit], and the
- 24 municipality is not the person's reemploying municipality, the
- 25 person again becomes a member of the retirement system, and the
- 26 person's retirement annuity is not suspended.
- (e) The additional benefit described by Subsection (d)(2)

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- 1 $[\frac{d}{d}]$ is payable as a standard service retirement benefit or, at the
- 2 election of the member, any optional benefit authorized under this
- 3 subtitle that is the actuarial equivalent of the standard
- 4 retirement benefit. The first benefit payment date under this
- 5 subsection is the later of the end of the month following the last
- 6 month of employment or the end of the month following the month in
- 7 which the person files an application for payment. The first
- 8 payment may not be made if the person has resumed employment that
- 9 would result in suspension of a benefit.
- 10 (f) If a person became an employee of a municipality other
- 11 than the person's reemploying municipality after the effective date
- 12 of the person's [beginning to receive a] retirement from a
- 13 participating municipality [benefit], and the person's service
- 14 retirement annuity was suspended under Section 852.108 as it
- 15 existed at the time of reemployment, the person may, on written
- 16 application to the retirement system, resume receiving the
- 17 suspended annuity.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
