## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the designation of certain premises as critical load
3	premises for electric service.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 38, Utilities Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 38.074 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 38.074. CRITICAL LOAD PREMISES DESIGNATION. (a) The
8	commission by rule shall establish a process for a transmission and
9	distribution utility to designate and prioritize the designation of
10	certain premises as critical load premises and adopt criteria for
11	determining eligibility for the designation and priority. In
12	establishing the process and adopting the criteria, the commission
13	shall coordinate with other agencies that have primary jurisdiction
14	over entities that own or operate premises that may be designated as
15	critical load premises.
16	(b) The eligibility criteria adopted under Subsection (a)
17	must allow for premises used by the following entities or for the
18	following activities to be eligible to be designated as critical
19	<pre>load premises:</pre>
20	(1) upstream natural gas production;
21	(2) midstream natural gas transportation;
22	(3) gas utilities;
23	(4) fuel production;
24	(5) nitrogen supply;

- 1 (6) hydrogen supply;
- 2 (7) water supply;
- 3 <u>(8) wastewater treatment; and</u>
- 4 <u>(9) telecommunications.</u>
- 5 (c) Annually, the commission shall submit to the
- 6 <u>legislature</u> a report regarding critical load premises
- 7 designations, including analysis of the implementation and results
- 8 of the designations.
- 9 (d) This section does not limit a transmission and
- 10 distribution utility's discretion to prioritize power delivery and
- 11 power restoration to the transmission and distribution utility's
- 12 customers as circumstances require.
- SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2022, the Public
- 14 Utility Commission of Texas shall submit to the legislature the
- 15 first report required by Section 38.074, Utilities Code, as added
- 16 by this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. If this Act takes effect immediately, the Public
- 18 Utility Commission of Texas shall adopt the rules required by
- 19 Section 38.074, Utilities Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 20 September 1, 2021. If this Act takes effect September 1, 2021, the
- 21 Public Utility Commission of Texas shall adopt rules as required by
- 22 Section 38.074, Utilities Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 23 November 1, 2021.
- 24 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
