2	relating to the designation of certain premises as critical load.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 38, Utilities Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 38.074 as follows:
6	Sec. 38.074. CRITICAL LOAD DESIGNATION. (a) The
7	commission by rule shall establish a process for priority of
8	designation and eligibility requirements for a transmission and
9	distribution utility to designate a premise as critical load. The
10	commission shall coordinate with other agencies with primary
11	jurisdiction over entities with critical load designation
12	premises.
13	(b) In providing eligibility requirements under Subsection
14	(a), the commission shall include premises for upstream natural gas
15	production, midstream natural gas transportation, fuel production,
16	nitrogen supply, hydrogen supply, water supply, and
17	telecommunications.
18	(c) The commission shall make an annual report to the
19	legislature regarding critical load entity designation, including
20	implementation and results, beginning no later than January 1,
21	2022.
22	SECTION 3. The Public Utility Commission shall adopt rules
23	as required by Section 38.074 Utilities Code, as added by this Act,
24	not later than September 1, 2021 if the Act takes immediate effect.

- 2 Section 38.074, Utilities Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 3 November 1, 2021 if the Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article II, Texas Constitution. If this Act
- 7 does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act
- 8 takes effect September 1, 2021.
