14	items inspected at an inspection station or by an inspector:

16	(2) wheel assembly;
17	(3) safety guards or flaps, if required by Section
18	547.606;
19	(4) brake system, including power brake unit;
20	(5) steering system, including power steering;
21	(6) lighting equipment;
22	(7) horns and warning devices;
23	(8) mirrors;
24	(9) windshield wipers;

- 1 (10) sunscreening devices, unless the vehicle is
- 2 exempt from sunscreen device restrictions under Section 547.613;
- 3 (11) front seat belts in vehicles on which seat belt
- 4 anchorages were part of the manufacturer's original equipment;
- 5 (12) exhaust system, including the muffler;
- 6 (13) exhaust emission system;
- 7 (14) fuel tank cap, using pressurized testing
- 8 equipment approved by department rule; and
- 9 (15) emissions control equipment as designated by
- 10 department rule.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
