- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 801, Occupations Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 801.365 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 801.365. BREEDING STOCK. (a) In this section,
- 8 "breeding stock" means a bovine animal intended by its owner or
- 9 caretaker, with the input of a veterinarian, to be used for
- 10 selective mating to maintain or enhance desirable genetic traits in
- 11 future generations and not intended, at the time a drug is
- 12 <u>administered to the animal as provided by this section, for human or</u>
- 13 <u>animal consumption. The term does not include a market animal.</u>
- 14 (b) A veterinarian may administer, prescribe, dispense, or
- 15 deliver any drug derived from a naturally occurring hormone in
- 16 breeding stock. The veterinarian shall determine and prescribe an
- 17 adequate withdrawal time for the drug.
- 18 <u>(c) An owner or caretaker may use a drug described by</u>
- 19 Subsection (b) in breeding stock in the manner prescribed by a
- 20 <u>veterinarian</u>.

- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
