5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 411.1742 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 411.1742. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION TO OPEN BURN PIT
9	REGISTRY FUND. (a) When a person applies for an original or renewal
10	license to carry a handgun under this subchapter, the person may
11	make a voluntary contribution in any amount to the open burn pit
12	registry fund established by Section 99.008, Health and Safety
13	Code.
14	(b) The department shall:
15	(1) include space on the first page of each
16	application for an original or renewal license to carry a handgun
17	that allows a person applying for an original or renewal license to
18	carry a handgun to indicate the amount that the person is
19	voluntarily contributing to the fund; and
20	(2) provide an opportunity for the person to
21	contribute to the fund during the application process for an

- 1 this section to the comptroller for deposit in the state treasury to
- 2 the credit of the open burn pit registry fund not later than the
- 3 14th day of each month. Before sending the money to the fund, the
- 4 department may deduct money equal to the amount of reasonable
- 5 expenses for administering this section.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 99, Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 7 Chapter 153 (H.B. 306), Acts of the 86th Legislature, Regular
- 8 Session, 2019, is amended by adding Section 99.008 to read as
- 9 follows:
- Sec. 99.008. OPEN BURN PIT REGISTRY FUND. (a) The open burn
- 11 pit registry fund is a special fund in the state treasury outside
- 12 the general revenue fund. The fund is composed of:
- (1) money transferred to the fund at the direction of
- 14 the legislature;
- 15 (2) gifts and grants contributed to the fund;
- 16 (3) the earnings of the fund; and
- 17 (4) money deposited to the credit of the fund under
- 18 Section 411.1742, Government Code.
- 19 (b) Money in the fund may be appropriated only to the
- 20 department. The department may use the money only for the purpose of
- 21 <u>creating and maintaining the open burn pit registry established</u>
- 22 under Section 99.003, except that the department may use the money
- 23 for any other purpose consistent with appropriation if the
- 24 department finds that contributions exceed the amount necessary for
- 25 adequately funding the open burn pit registry.
- 26 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 27 of this Act, the Department of Public Safety shall modify the

- 1 application form for a license to carry a handgun to satisfy the
- 2 requirement of Section 411.1742, Government Code, as added by this
- 3 Act.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
