- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1952.301, Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows: 6
- 7 Sec. 1952.301. LIMITATIONS AND DUTIES REGARDING REPAIR OF
- MOTOR VEHICLE [LIMITATION ON PARTS, PRODUCTS, OR REPAIR PERSONS OR 8
- FACILITIES PROHIBITED]. (a) 9 Under [Except as provided by rules
- adopted by the commissioner, under] an automobile insurance policy 10
- that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed in this state, an 11
- 12 insurer may not directly or indirectly limit the insurer's coverage
- under a policy covering damage to a motor vehicle that has an 13
- 14 unexpired manufacturer's warranty.
- (a-1) Conduct prohibited by Subsection (a) includes [by]: 15
- 16 specifying the brand, type, kind, age, vendor,
- 17 supplier, or condition of parts or products or the repair process
- that may be used to repair the vehicle, unless the specified part, 18
- product, or repair process is the manufacturer's warranted part, 19
- product, or repair process; or 20
- 21 limiting the beneficiary of the policy from
- selecting a repair person or facility to repair damage to the 22
- 23 vehicle.

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24 In settling a liability claim by a third party against (b)

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- 1 an insured for property damage, claimed by the third party, to a
- 2 motor vehicle that has an unexpired manufacturer's warranty, an
- 3 insurer may not require the third-party claimant to have the motor
- 4 vehicle repairs made by a particular repair person or facility or to
- 5 use a particular brand, type, kind, age, vendor, supplier, or
- 6 condition of parts or products or a particular repair process,
- 7 unless the part, product, or repair process is the manufacturer's
- 8 warranted part, product, or repair process.
- 9 (c) If a covered repair to a third party's or the insured's
- 10 motor vehicle requires an original equipment manufacturer's part or
- 11 product that is no longer manufactured to restore the motor vehicle
- 12 to the vehicle's pre-damaged condition, the insurer shall use the
- 13 insurer's best efforts to ensure the repair can be made using that
- 14 necessary part or product along with any necessary repair process.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an insurance policy that is delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 17 renewed on or after January 1, 2022. A policy delivered, issued for
- 18 delivery, or renewed before that date is governed by the law as it
- 19 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
- 20 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
