## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to required posting of information regarding the office of the state long-term care ombudsman on certain long-term care 3 facilities' Internet websites. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 4, Health and Safety Code, is 7 amended by adding Chapter 260C to read as follows: CHAPTER 260C. POSTING OF OFFICE OF STATE LONG-TERM CARE OMBUDSMAN 8 9 INFORMATION BY CERTAIN FACILITIES Sec. 260C.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "long-term 10 care facility" means: 11 12 (1) a nursing facility licensed under Chapter 242; 13 (2) an assisted living facility licensed under Chapter 14 247; or (3) any other facility under the jurisdiction of the 15 16 state long-term care ombudsman established under Subchapter F, Chapter 101A, Human Resources Code. 17 Sec. 260C.002. POSTING OF OFFICE OF STATE LONG-TERM CARE 18 OMBUDSMAN INFORMATION ON INTERNET WEBSITE. A long-term care 19 facility shall post on the facility's Internet website information 20 about the office of the state long-term care ombudsman established 21 under Subchapter F, Chapter 101A, Human Resources Code, including 22 23 information regarding the office's: 24 (1) role as an advocate for residents of long-term

3	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
