12	(1) a nursing facility licensed under Chapter 242;
13	(2) an assisted living facility licensed under Chapter
14	<u>247; or</u>
15	(3) any other facility under the jurisdiction of the
16	state long-term care ombudsman established under Subchapter F,
17	Chapter 101A, Human Resources Code.
18	Sec. 260C.002. POSTING OF OFFICE OF STATE LONG-TERM CARE
19	OMBUDSMAN INFORMATION ON INTERNET WEBSITE. A long-term care
20	facility shall post on the facility's Internet website information
21	about the office of the state long-term care ombudsman established
22	under Subchapter F, Chapter 101A, Human Resources Code, including
23	information regarding the office's:
24	(1) role in regulating the facility; and
