(a) Nothing in Section 1806.053, 9 1806.054, 1806.104, 1806.1041, 1806.153, 1806.1541, or 1806.156 10 may be construed as: 11 12 (1) permitting an unfair method of competition or a false, misleading, or deceptive act or practice under Section 13 14 17.46, Business & Commerce Code; or 15 (2) prohibiting an insurer or an insurer's agent from 16 offering or giving to an insured or applicant, for free or at a discounted price in a manner that is not unfairly discriminatory to 17 insureds or applicants of the same class and of essentially the same 18 19 hazard, services or other offerings that relate to loss control of the risks covered under the insured's policy, subject to Subsection 20 (b). 21 (b) The cost to the insurer or the insurer's agent offering 22 23 the product or service to any given customer must be reasonable in comparison to that customer's premiums or insurance coverage for 24

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1 the policy class.

2 <u>(c) The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary to</u> 3 <u>implement this section.</u>
