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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the authorized activities of a manufacturer's agent's warehousing permit holder. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Sections 55.01(a), (b), and (c), Alcoholic Beverage Code, as effective September 1, 2021, are amended to read 6 7 as follows: (a) The holder of a manufacturer's agent's warehousing 8 9 permit may: receive alcoholic [malt] beverages from 10 (1) any license or permit holder that is authorized to sell the alcoholic 11 beverages to licensed or permitted wholesalers or distributors in 12 this state [the holder of a nonresident brewer's license] and store 13 14 the alcoholic beverages on the permitted premises; (2) ship, cause to be shipped, sell, and otherwise 15 16 transfer the alcoholic [malt] beverages to licensed or permitted wholesalers or distributors in this state who are authorized to 17 receive the alcoholic beverages and to persons outside this state 18 who are qualified to receive the alcoholic [malt] beverages under 19 20 the regulatory laws of the state or other jurisdiction in which the 21 alcoholic [malt] beverages are received; [and] 22 (3) return alcoholic [malt] beverages to the license 23 or permit holder [brewer] from which they were originally received;

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and

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<u>(4) unpack, repack, or co-pack the alcoholic beverages</u>
<u>in any combination or configuration</u>.

The holder of a manufacturer's agent's warehousing 3 (b) permit may ship malt beverages only to distributors in this state 4 who have been issued a territorial designation by the [actual] 5 brewer or the primary source of American supply of the brand or 6 brands to be shipped. This territorial designation for the sale of 7 8 malt beverages must be under and a part of the agreement entered into between the [actual] brewer or the primary source of American 9 supply of the brand and the distributor under Subchapters C and D, 10 Chapter 102. This chapter does not affect the requirement that the 11 [actual] brewer or the primary source of American supply, and the 12 agreement between the [actual] brewer or the primary source of 13 14 American supply and the distributor, comply with Subchapters C and 15 D, Chapter 102.

16 (c) <u>Alcoholic</u> [Malt] beverages received at premises 17 permitted under this chapter that are not labeled and approved for 18 sale in this state may be held and stored at the premises and may be 19 shipped from the premises if the <u>alcoholic</u> [malt] beverages are 20 consigned and transported to qualified persons in other states or 21 jurisdictions where their sale is legal.

22 SECTION 2. Section 55.03, Alcoholic Beverage Code, as 23 effective September 1, 2021, is amended to read as follows:

24 Sec. 55.03. ELIGIBILITY FOR PERMIT. A manufacturer's 25 agent's warehousing permit may be issued to an entity:

26 (1) that receives <u>alcoholic</u> [malt] beverages from 27 another entity, or that other entity's immediate successor in

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1 interest, that:

2 (A) is located and chartered in the United3 Mexican States;

4 (B) has held, for the two years preceding the5 date of the application:

6 (i) a nonresident manufacturer's license,7 nonresident brewer's permit, and a nonresident seller's permit;

8 (ii) a nonresident brewer's license and a9 nonresident seller's permit; or

10 (iii) a combination of Subparagraph (i) and 11 Subparagraph (ii); and

(C) during each of those two years has shipped or caused to be shipped into this state for ultimate sale to qualified distributors and wholesalers in this state at least one-half million barrels of malt beverages of the various brands manufactured or brewed by the entity; and

17 (2) whose employees, located in this state or
18 elsewhere, perform the activities authorized under Chapters 36 and
19 73 on behalf of the entity.

20 SECTION 3. Section 55.05, Alcoholic Beverage Code, as 21 effective September 1, 2021, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 55.05. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. The commission shall require monthly reports from a permit holder under this chapter showing the brands, types, sizes of containers, and quantities of <u>alcoholic</u> [malt] beverages received at and shipped from the premises to persons authorized to receive them. The reports must conform in all respects to the requirements and forms prescribed by

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1 the commission and contain any other information required by the 2 commission.

3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
