## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the use of a flashing warning signal light and certain

- 3 other equipment by a person operating a school bus.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 547.701, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (c) When a school bus is being stopped or is stopped on a
- 9 highway to permit students to board or exit the bus, the operator of
- 10 the bus shall activate all flashing warning signal lights and other
- 11 equipment on the bus designed to warn other drivers that the bus is
- 12 stopping to load or unload children.
- 13 (c-1) A person may not operate [such] a light or other
- 14 equipment described by Subsection (c) except when a school [the]
- 15 bus is being stopped or is stopped on a highway to:
- 16 <u>(1)</u> permit <u>a student</u> [students] to board or exit the
- 17 bus; or
- 18 (2) distribute to a student or the parent or guardian
- 19 of a student:
- 20 <u>(A) food; or</u>
- 21 (B) technological equipment for use by the
- 22 student for educational purposes.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

C.S.H.B. No. 3992

- 1 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 2 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 3 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 4 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 5 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 6 before that date.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
