- SECTION 1. Section 12.110, Education Code, is amended by 5
- amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (d-1) to read as 6
- follows: 7

- 8 The commissioner shall approve or deny an application
- 9 based on:
- (1) documented evidence collected 10 through
- application review process; 11
- 12 (2) merit; [and]
- 13 (3) other criteria as adopted by the commissioner,
- 14 which must include:
- criteria relating to the capability of the 15 (A)
- 16 applicant to carry out the responsibilities provided by the charter
- and the likelihood that the applicant will operate a school of high 17
- quality; 18
- criteria relating to 19 (B) improving student
- 20 performance and encouraging innovative programs; and
- 21 a statement from any school district whose
- 22 enrollment is likely to be affected by the open-enrollment charter
- 23 school, including information relating to any financial difficulty
- that a loss in enrollment may have on the district; and 24

- 1 (4) consideration of public comments on the
- 2 application received under Subsection (d-1).
- 3 (d-1) Before approving or denying an application received
- 4 under Subsection (a), the commissioner shall provide not less than
- 5 60 days for public comment on the application.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 12.114, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (b-1) and amending Subsection (c) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (b-1) The commissioner shall provide not less than 60 days
- 10 for public comment on a request for approval for an expansion
- 11 <u>amendment submitted under this section.</u>
- 12 (c) The [Not later than the 60th day after the date that a
- 13 charter holder submits to the] commissioner shall provide to the
- 14 charter holder written notice of approval or disapproval of a
- 15 completed request for [approval for] an expansion amendment, as
- 16 defined by commissioner rule, including a new school amendment, <u>as</u>
- 17 soon as practicable and not later than the 10th business day after
- 18 the date the period for public comment on the request provided under
- 19 Subsection (b-1) expires [the commissioner shall provide to the
- 20 charter holder written notice of approval or disapproval of the
- 21 amendment].
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
